Staging Life "It Starts Within"

Reread Galatians 4:4-7

1. Throughout this series we have used the phrase "there is no win in comparison." How do you explain it in your own words, and when has comparing yourself to others motivated you, or not.
2. When you read Galatians 4:4-5 , Paul explains we were born "under the law." What do you think that means?
3. In the sermon, Pastor Jon talked said that there is a universal sense of "ought to" or "ought not to." Do you believe that to be true? List some examples?
4. Have you ever secretly celebrated someone's failure? Where does that come from?
5. One question lifted up in the sermon was, "who do perfect parents compare their children too?" In baptism, we are adopted by God so that we might experience what?
6. Whose estimation of you should you use?
7. We have the greatest potential when we are found inside, not outside, of God's will. Agree?
8. Action Item: Each morning wakeup and declare, "There is no win in comparison." "I am going to take my cue from the one who loves me, sent his son to die for me, and fixed what is broken in me." It is in God's will where I will become all I am supposed to be.
