Staging Life “Digging Out”

Reread Matthew 25:14-30

1. Throughout this series we have asked the questions: Who or what do you look to as a reference to determine if you are ok? Or to determine how well are you doing? Where does that question apply in your life?
2. The Parable of the Talents did not happen. It's a story to teach us how God views the world and us in it. What gifts would you identify as God-given in your life? Why do you think it's a hard to answer such a question?
3. In the parable, what was the reason that the 'one bagger' gives for not investing the money?
4. Do we sometimes do the same thing as the one bagger? Any examples?
5. The Master seems to strike a harsh and un-Christian response to the 'one-bagger,' do you agree?
6. When has God given you great responsibility in your life?
7. The bottom line for this parable is this; the issue is not what we have in our life, it's what we do with what we have been entrusted. How has this idea challenged you? How does it help?
8. What action items can you take away from this series? What do you believe God is calling you to do with the unique life you have been given?
